## **Principals Report:**

Mr. Sanchez reported on several topics.

- Students with do elective registration for 2016-17. Current 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grades will register the week of February 15<sup>th</sup>. They will fill out two forms. One the counselors keep, one they bring home for parents to sign. If a parent signed copy is turned in, that is what they will go by.
- High school registration for 8<sup>th</sup> graders is February 11 & 12<sup>th</sup>. You will need to enroll with your home school unless you've already been accepted to a magnet program. You cannot use this registration process to register with Magnet school.
- 7<sup>th</sup> Graders will test in March for UHS. It is a required test.
- Spirit Week is February 8 to 12<sup>th</sup>. Monday is twin day, Tuesday is Neon day, Wednesday is sports day, Thursday is Harry Potter day, Friday is red/pink out, you can wear red or pink bottoms on Friday, no uniform bottoms needed on Friday.
- Parent-Teacher conference are February 11<sup>th</sup>. Not conferences on the 12<sup>th</sup>. Early out on both days. Lunch is 12:16 to 12:50. Buses load at 12:50. Please let your child know where to meet to avoid calls to the office. 1:20 to 6:30 conferences can be scheduled through the counselor's office. 6:30-7:30 you can meet with teachers in the cafeteria through conference drop in.
- Valentine's Dance is February 12<sup>th</sup>, 5:00p to 7pm. Students may not stay at the school after lunch is out on Friday. They must leave campus.
- Rodeo Break is February 26<sup>th</sup> – 27<sup>th</sup>, there is no school.
- Mansfeld Garden: The bike rack area will be split with a chain link fence. Two bike racks will be removed. Garden area will be locked. Bike rack area will have an open gate. GEMs will be tending the garden. STEM Project. 7<sup>th</sup> grade will do a tree cloning project as part of Social studies. There trees will go in the garden in containers.
- Marquee. Marcus Jones has assigned Linda Wright on the marquee project. We have received a quote from the TUSD vendor. It will cost \$41,000 to replace the current marquee with an electric marquee. Cost includes providing electricity and internet to the marquee sign, new sign and installation and taking the old marquee away. ## **Community Representative Report:**

Ms. Mosconi: There are some parking leads, one for football pass, one for permit parking. She has info for both interested parties.

Jodi Guitierrez has \$710 to deposit in bank for 8<sup>th</sup> grade Disneyland trip. She is requesting a line item in budget.

There are 182 tutored students, who are seen 2 times a week. They are taken out of two different classes, so they teacher only misses the student once. They are taken out of electives. They are UA students who have to be fingerprinted. Tutors come from literacy programs, some from practicum, some are Arizona Mentor Society.

Sky School will be offered again this year. It will cost \$10/student. They will go during the week. 30-35 students can attend. School will be funding \$90 per student.
