STATEMENT OF PURPOSE
Mansfeld Magnet Middle Schhol is a community dedicated to student academic and personal success for today and in the future through STEM education.

Mansfeld Magnet Middle School teachers, staff and families are all considered equal partners in our student's education. Working together, Mansfeld Magnet Middle School staff, families and the community can help our students to achieve their greatest potential. ANNUAL TITLE 1 MEETING

Mansfeld Magnet Middle School staff and parents will be informed of the Title 1 budget information that will be shared in the fall and then again in the spring.

ANNUAL EVALUATION

A school/parent compact will be given to parents, students, and teachers for the purpose of each individual setting goals for themselves to help foster positive development of the student. The compact should be reviewed with the student and parent quarterly to revisit goals. Annually parents may review and give input regarding the parental compact and this policy at a Site Council meeting or a PTSO meeting.

PARENTAL CAPACITY

A survey will be sent home annually to determine the needs of our families. School personnel will provide a variety of meeting times and locations for the mentioned activities, as requested, to serve families.



Parent Involvement

We will collaborate with the community to provide workshops to fit the needs of our families. Workshops may include Math Awareness, ESL for adults and parental access to view you student's progress.

Communication

Parents will be notified of school functions through newsletters, websites, flyers, and the Parent Compact. Language interpreters will be made available for families as necessary. Every effort will be made to communicate in the language parents/guardians have indicated is their primary language. Translations of written communications will be made available when the need is determined.

The School Community Liaison serves as a communication link between home, school, and the community.

Volunteering

Parent volunteers are encouraged to participate in our school community and to share their expertise.

Learning at Home

Bridge student learning between school and home with curricular support, resources and teacher assistance. Workshops will be offered though Title1 support locations.

Decision Making

Parents will help the school and /or district make important decisions through attending meetings with our PTSO, Site Council (Decision Mak-

ing Council), and School Community Partnership Council (SCPC).
